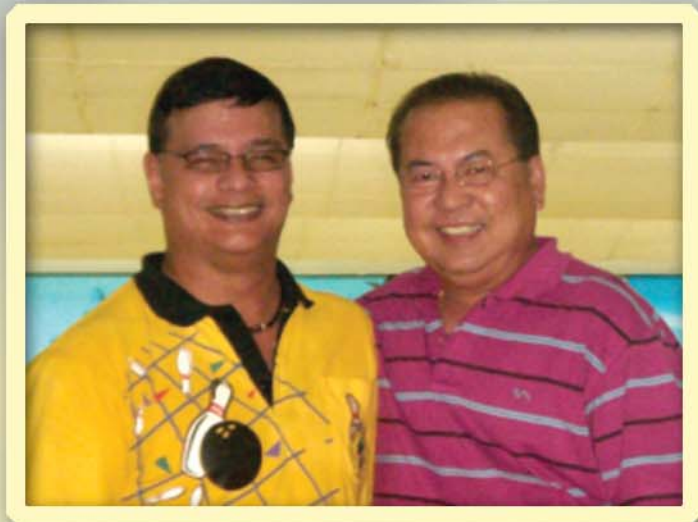


UNTALAN PULLS THROUGH IN EXTRA FRAMES



Paul Untalan opened up the finals match with a barrage of strikes taking the early lead on a four bagger over 4th seed Nestor Valencia. Untalan led by as many as 25 pins after six

frames with both bowlers missing spares on the sixth. With a strike on the seventh frame Untalan left a 2-10 split

leave hitting seven pins on his fill frame and used all the handicap advantage he had to tie the match and send it to extra frames with a 172 game and 25 handicap. In the two frame roll off, Untalan struck on his first frame while Valencia missed a 6-10 conversion and

on the eighth which gave Valencia room to close the gap. Valencia spared on the ninth frame while Untalan struck to maintain the lead. However, it was the final frame that proved disaster for the top seed as he missed the four pin leave wide left finishing the game with 180 pins plus 17 handicap for a 197 total while Valencia spared a seven pin

a 2-4-5 leave which enabled Untalan to claim the monthly title 29+3 to 18+5.

In the semi final round, Untalan staved off a surging Roland Ponce with a 198+17 to 171+25 victory while 2nd seed Rudy Palaganas went toe to toe with Nestor Valencia before falling to the lower seed 158+9 to 167+25.

Untalan led all bowlers in the six game qualifying rounds with a 1345 total on 102 pins of handicap bowling games of 255, 197, 167, 257, 206 and 161. Palaganas followed suit with 1307 (54) averging 208 pins per game. Joe Mafnas finished in third with 1275 (150), followed by Valencia 1262 (150), Terry Roberto 1256 (216), Edgar Caper 1256 (132), Roger Mejares 1254 (198), Joe Murphy 1254 (186), Clyde Santos 1248 (198) and Roland Ponce round off the top ten.

ZIALCITA, SMITH GRAB MARCH GUAM BOWLER TITLES



Rey Zialcita literally walked out of the bowling center prior to winning his first Bud Light Guam Bowler of the Lanes monthly title held at the Leo Palace Resort's Bowling Center in Manenggon Hills on Saturday, March 8, 2008. However, his walk out wasn't in protest, but under the notion that he didn't bowl a high enough game to move into the next round. As it turned out, he qualified number six after the first round cut and went on to win the monthly title against Nestor Valencia 220+11 to 180+14.

Zialcita and Valencia qualified for the finals bowling the highest two games during the semi-final round. Zialcita rolled a 229 game plus 11 pins of handicap to take the top seed followed by Valencia's 204+14. Travis Meno finished third with 178+17 while Gavin Baker's 146+32 landed him a fourth place finish.

In the women's division, newcomer Giesel Smith used every bit of her handicap to slip by Leanne Rankin in the finals 125+53 to 146+20. Leanne Rankin was unable to connect on strikes and instead left splits committing the game to Smith. Rankin led every round throughout the tournament finishing the semi final

match with a 222+20 game and the quarter final round 190+20.

In the qualifying rounds held earlier in the day, Keith Guerrero led all bowlers with a 867 four game total with no handicap followed by Travis Meno 786+68, Lester Santiago 766+32, Gavin Baker 647+128, Joey Miranda III 773+0, Matt Goyette

738+32, Nestor Valencia 701+56, Rey Zialcita 696+44, Romy Dela Paz 687+44, and Jonathan Smith 593+128 round off the top ten.

Elliot posts new high series for the year



Aaron Elliott put on a strike fest during the Budweiser Tuesday Night Mixed League bowling 28 of a possible 36 strikes on lanes 7 and 8 and setting a new high series for the year beating Rick Duenas' 784 posted earlier in the year. Elliott who bowls with Team AON began the first game with a nine count spare and then strung from the second to 10th frame before leaving a ten pin on the eleventh frame with a spare for a 279 game. On his second game, he struck from the first to the seventh frame then spared a nine count in the eighth stringing three more strikes until a nine count in the 12th frame for a 278 game. In the final game, Elliott got caught with a 4-6-9-10 split in the seventh frame, however, he managed to strike on the first six frames and the eight through tenth frame before converting another nine count leave on the eleventh for a 253 game and an 810 total.

The bowler with the highest three game series of the year will receive a \$600.00 check courtesy of the Central Lanes Bowling Center of which leagues are sanctioned by the Guam Bowling Congress.

BIRTHDAY WISH COMES THROUGH

It was a birthday wish that came through for Shannon Bukikosa who claimed her second Budweiser Prince of the Lanes title in three months alongside King of the Lanes Jay Leon Guerrero held on Sunday, March 16, 2008 at the Central Lanes Bowling Center.

Leon Guerrero ousted top seed Aaron Elliott in the monthly finals of the King division as he closed out the match with four consecutive strikes on a 227 to 193 route to claim his first King title of the year. The match started out evenly as both bowlers turned in spares and strikes until Elliott left a 4-6-10 split on the fourth frame which fueled Leon Guerrero's march doubling up on the opportunity to take a 15 pin lead and never looked back thus claiming the trophy and cash prize.

In the semi-final matches Elliott dispatched 10th seed Rudy Palaganas 216-185 while second seed Leon Guerrero stopped a streaking 8th seed Ricky Duenas 237-206. Duenas bowled the highest game of the tournament during the first elimination match against 4th seed Joey Miranda with a 279-160 dubbing.

Elliott led all bowlers by a mile during the qualifying rounds held earlier in the day amassing a six game total of 1333 pins on games of 228, 243, 235, 235, 197 and 195 for a 222 average. Leon Guerrero finished second with a 1265 total followed by Keith Guerrero 1243, Joey Miranda III 1219, Duane Camacho 1175, Virgil Toledo 1144, Rey Zialcita 1144, Duenas 1129, Brian Manibusan 1115 and Palaganas 1108 rounds off the top ten who proceeded to the knock off rounds.

In the Prince of the Lanes, the birthday girl was unstoppable in her quest for a second monthly title defeating each of her opponents by no less than two pins per round. In the first round Bukikosa ran past 4th seed Jonathan Cortez 168+35 to 113+47, then disseminated 3rd seed Joe B. Cruz in round two 173+35 to 147+24. In the semi-final round she toppled



2nd seed Jeffrey Fejerang 204+35 to 138+51 and marched right through top seed Jared Gutierrez 182+35 to 146+49. In the other semi-final match, Gutierrez defeated 6th seed Yuuki Guzman 186+49 to 179+38 to advance to the finals.

Gutierrez topped all Prince of the Lanes competitors earlier in the day with a 1364 total including 294 pins of handicap followed by Fejerang's 1287 (306), Cruz 1281(144), Cortez 1271 (282), Madisson Willis 1246 (414), Guzman 1187 (228), Kin Sablan 1181 (120), Bukikosa 1180 (210), John Leon Guerrero 1179 (180), and Arlan Aquino Jr. 1155 (132) rounded off the top ten.

The next Budweiser King and Prince of the Lanes will be held on Sunday, April 20, 2008 at the Central Lanes Bowling Center.

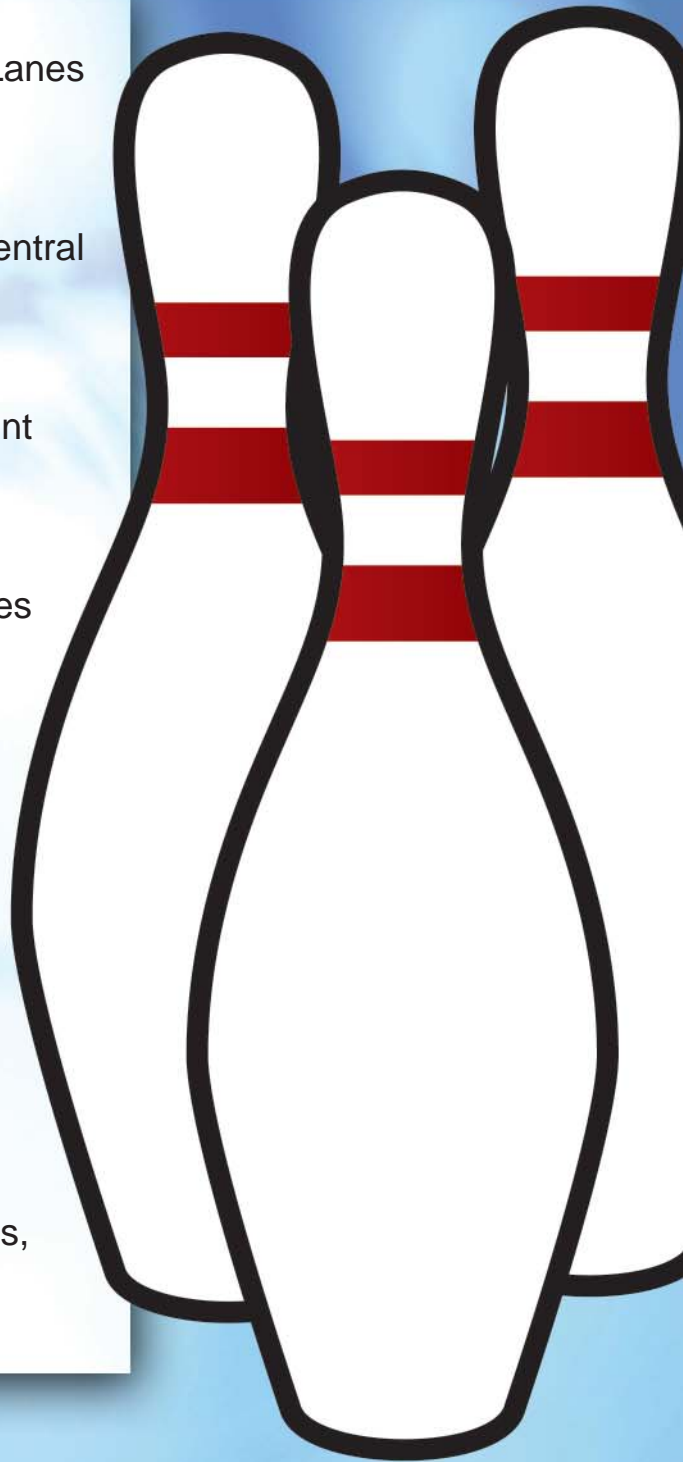
